YMCA Lifeguard, Day Camp, provides leadership for children ages 5-12 in YMCA Day Camps and is responsible for supervising and delivering all water programs for the various groups, as well as ensuring all participants and staff are following policies and procedures. Lifeguards will also deliver water safety procedures to participants and staff, and will maintain communication with group leaders, volunteers, parents, and children regarding emergency procedures for waterfront/beach activities. Lifeguards will also ensure all water equipment is kept in safe working order.

- Registered as a full-time student in the previous academic year, and intends to return to school on a full-time basis in the next academic year (proof of student status will be required)
- Available to work full-time hours for entire contract (no exceptions will be made)
- Experience working as a lifeguard, and with children and families in a recreational setting
